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Qualitative Drug Screening (UA)

Dear Patient:

Intermountain Neurology Clinic and Skyline Pain clinic requires all patients that receive controlled substances for management of chronic pain submit to a qualitative urine drug screening for controlled substances, hereinafter referred to as "UA". The UA is required at the time of each visit, prior to receiving prescriptions for medication. The UA is one of the means by which we are able to provide quality care to our patients while adhering to state and federal guidelines concerning the prescribing of narcotics.

It is your responsibility to check with your insurance to make sure what your benefits are. We do accept most insurance plans; however, our providers may not be contracted with your plan. You will be responsible for all co-pays, deductibles, con-insurance and non-covered charges. Non-covered charges are defined as those charges which your insurance company denies per its policies and procedures. Again, it is your responsibility to verify with your insurance plan whether or not a UA is a covered procedure and any limitations on said coverage.

Non-payment or partial payment of UA by your insurance coverage does not mean you will no longer have UA done at time of visit. NO CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES WILL BE PRESCRIBED without UA at time of visit.
